4. Interviews:
 - a. Legal answer: don't reveal you have diabetes. It can be a cause for invisible discrimination. Your employer cannot force you to reveal disability
 - b. Real answer: Each individual makes their own choice. Some people never want to hide who they are, and screw any risk. If you don't like me for who I am, then I don't want to work there anyway. Other people really need the job and can't take any risk of hidden discrimination.
